The **Glenn Almany Memorial Prize** is awarded to acknowledge Glenn’s scientific achievements and inspire the next generation by his dreams. The prize is awarded to the graduate student whose research required them to work with people beyond traditional academic boundaries to make a difference or which has the potential to influence policy, management or practice.

1. Please nominate **one** of your published journal articles which either:

- A. Required you to work with people beyond traditional academic boundaries to make a difference. For example, NGOs, resource managers, communities, other practitioners, policy makers etc. Or,
- B. Has the potential to influence policy, management or practice.
